在四月, 紐約CBS屬下的FM92.3 電台一個名 Doghouse 的節目, 曾兩次播放侮辱華人和婦女的節目, 「傳統家庭促進會」(簡稱: 傳家)響應美華協會的電郵反抗運動, 在電台, 報章和電郵網上發起簽名及寫電郵給CBS行動, 結果CBS宣佈解僱 Doghouse 的節目主持人, 並取消該節目。

鼓勵學生看色情電影，教導學生接受同性戀和戀童癖等。在此同時，保守和基督教的思想則被禁止發表。

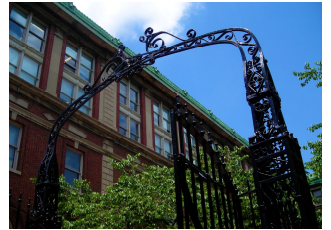
有一個叫 www.StudentsForAcademicFreedom.org 的網站揭露，保守思想的教授，常不被長期顧用或被邀為講員。而大學中則有一個叫「左傾宗教運動」，

它單單注重貧窮、地球暖化和民權等問題而忽略道德，允許墮胎、同性戀、安樂死等。

專欄作家 Michelle Malkin 在 Jewish World Review 曾發表一文章說，在一著名加州大學的一些男廁內，同性戀者常用作性活動的相會點，他們還在大學支持的網址上列出各男廁的地點，而大學每年支助

給出版這網址的 Queer Resource Center \$9000。而該加大每年支助基督教的 Campus Crusade for Christ 只有 \$200。

有一些大學甚至接納同性戀者和變性人的要求，開設了不分性別的洗手間。在很多學生宿舍裏，已有免費派發避孕套的機器。



除此之外，不少學生首次離開家庭，便染上飲酒、吸毒和網上沈溺的壞習慣。

家長們從未面對如此來自外界的凌厲挑戰。若要保護和訓練孩子，讓他們不受壞影響，應從強化他們的道德觀和意志力開始。

教孩子同性婚姻之對錯

不少家長曾向我們表示不滿學校老師教導他們的子女同性婚姻是正常和合潮流的，很多孩子們不懂對錯，欣然接受，他們不知如何改正孩子的婚姻觀念。

譚博士提議對孩子舉以下例子：「孩子，假若爸爸告訴你由明天起，我要媽媽搬走，然

後請一位男朋友搬進家，代替媽媽，而從此你就有兩位爸爸，你喜歡這樣合潮流的家庭嗎？」當孩子們聽見後，便會理解同性婚姻的不合理之處，十之其九都不會接受。

現在同性戀已合法，家長已需面對學校對子女的思想洗腦，說同性

戀和同性婚姻都是正常的，試想有一天同性婚姻真的合法化，家長更難向子女解釋婚姻的正確定義。教導孩子「對與不對」的觀念，現在就應從家庭和教會開始，更需阻止同性婚姻成為合法。

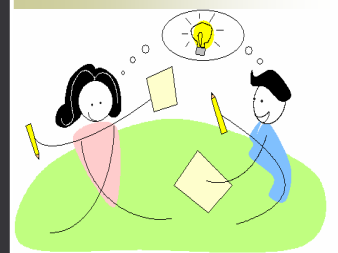

TFC SPEAKS UP ON ETHNIC AND BIBLICAL ISSUES

In April, the DJs hosting the Doghouse radio program of WFNY (New York) called a Chinese restaurant and humiliated three restaurant workers on the air with racial and sexual insults. TFC joined the Organization of Chinese Americans to protest to CBS Radio and helped to successfully terminate the radio program, as well as remove the DJs.

In May, the student newspaper of Chinese University of Hong Kong published articles suggesting

students explore incest and bestiality. Upon warning from the school administration, the student initiated thousands of complaints about the Bible, claiming that Scripture reported similar events and should also be censored. TFC issued to the press a defense of the Bible and rebuke of the students.

When a group of liberal ministers held a press conference in San Francisco voicing their support for gay marriage, TFC re-

sponded on TV and newspaper that the ministers misinterpreted the Bible and that they do not represent the mainstream Christian views.

In late June, TFC joined San Francisco churches to pray in the "America Return to God" prayer rally.

This has been an eventful quarter; Dr. Tam spoke a total of 14 times to church groups, radio, TV, newspaper reporters and seminary students.



THE LIE THAT SAME-SEX MARRIAGE IS COOL

When sharing at different church fellowships, troubled parents often worry that their children are told by their teachers that same-sex marriage is normal and cool. These parents are caught off guard and do not know how to correct their children's thinking. Dr. Tam suggested that parents can calmly ask the children the following: "Johnny, suppose you come home one day from

school and dad tells you that I asked your mom to leave the family. Instead of mom, I asked my boyfriend to move in and replaced mom. Now you have two dads. Do you think that's fine and cool?" When children can visualize such events in their own families, ten out of ten would realize how unnatural it is.

With the legalization of homosexuality, parents

already have a tough time fighting the school indoctrination of their children that homosexuality is normal. Imagine if same-sex marriage were legalized, how much more difficult it would be for parents to explain to their children the right concept of marriage. Teaching of right or wrong must start early on in the family and churches.

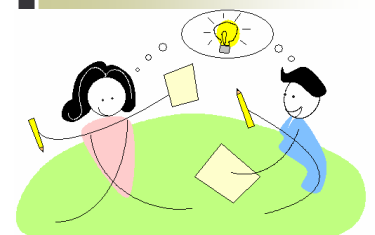
In the post-modern cul-

ture, there is no absolute right or wrong. Today's youth have been trained by the education system and the media to define their code of conduct by personal experience and feelings rather than by moral values. This idea of relativism is much more prevalent in college.

Columnist David Horowitz reported a vast

imbalance of political representation in the departments of humanities, arts, social, political, and educational sciences. About ninety percent of professors are Democrats, and many of them teach with an extreme left perspective on social issues. how some professors used their classes to trumpet pornography and homosexuality. On top of that, conservative and religious views are silenced and not given a fair chance for expression. The website, www.StudentsForAcademicFreedom.org, revealed that conservative professors are often denied tenure because of their beliefs. Conservative speakers are seldom invited to speak at college seminars or graduation ceremonies. Meanwhile, a "religious left" movement is surfacing to lure Christian students with a liberal agenda. They focus on poverty, global warming, and human rights issues only, while ignoring the problems of abortion, euthanasia, homosexuality, and promiscuity.

Michelle Malkin wrote in the Jewish World Review that the bathrooms of a well acclaimed University of California campus are used by homosexuals as a

meeting place for sexual encounters. University-funded and -sponsored websites are used to publish such popular meeting places. To illustrate the left-leaning policy of the institution, the Queer Resource Center, publisher of the site, receives \$9,000 per year from the university, while Campus Crusade for Christ receives only \$200 per year.

On a number of campuses, gender-neutral bathrooms have been opened, at the request of homosexuals and transgenders. Vending machines giving out free condoms were also installed in residential halls of many campuses.

Other than these top-down problems, many college students, when living on their own, acquire habits of drinking, drug use, and excessive online gaming. The former two abuses are frequently present in rape cases, while the latter is



often related to a drop in grades and an increase in anti-social behavior.

Never before have parents faced so many challenges in protecting their children from external influences. Strengthening their children's morals and willpower is perhaps the most important training parents can give.
